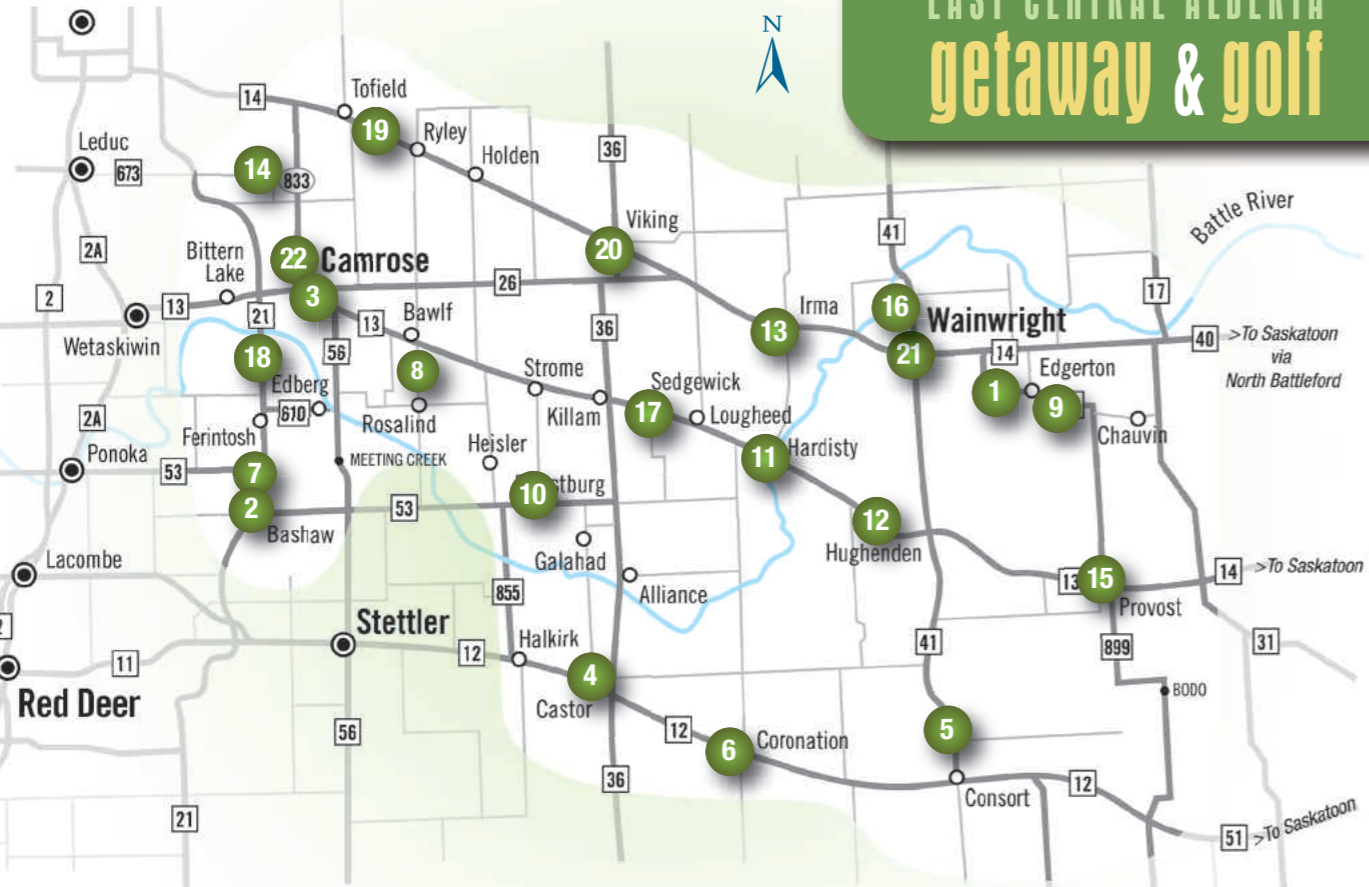

“Teed off” with long wait times and pricey green fees, then take a “drive” to East Central Alberta to tee up!

With a selection of 22 unique and challenging courses and 243 holes, East Central Alberta is the perfect choice for a total golf getaway. Whether you’re planning a single day trip or a multi day golf immersion, East Central Alberta’s courses combine great golf with a great fresh air country experience.

The golf experience includes a course built in 1922, a course where you need to cross the highway to play through and another with a “hangman’s noose” located on a fairway tree to provide added incentive for an accurate shot.

The courses also have interesting geography with locations in provincial parks and scenic valleys and most offer the ever-popular 19th watering hole, including one in a restored barn, originally built in 1912.

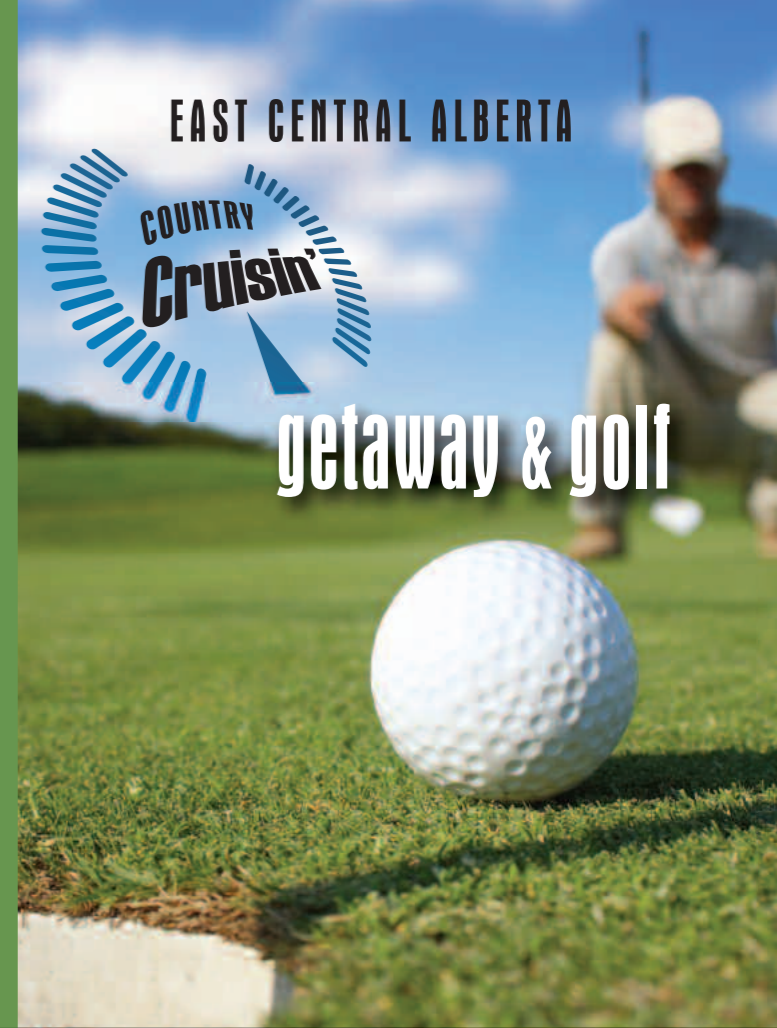
For outdoor enthusiasts, many of the golf courses offer camping/recreational vehicle facilities on their properties making your trip to the golf course that much shorter.

1 Arm Lake Recreation Area

16 km east and 10 km south of the Town of Wainwright off Secondary Hwy 610 **EDGERTON** (8 km west) 780-842-4727



A relaxing course featuring a variety of terrain from flat ground to rolling hills (with sand greens) in proximity to Arm Lake.

2 Bashaw Golf and Country Club

Nestled along the shores of Buffalo Lake, the course features tree lined fairways, water hazards, and doglegs – a golfer's delight.

3 Camrose Golf and Country Club

Tree-lined fairways situated along the banks of Stoney Creek provide a variety of challenges for both seasoned and beginner golfers – the perfect opportunity to mix and match skillsets. Featuring beautiful Mirror Lake (holes 4, 5, and 6) and the many swans that make this lake their home.

4 Castor Golf Course

Hwy 12 **CASTOR** 403-882-2112



The course plays fairly open, but when the wind is up the small surface greens can be challenging targets. The good news is that if you master the 2nd hole, you're on your way to a great golf game!

5 Consort Lakeview Golf Club

Hwy 41 – 12 km north of **CONSORT** 403-577-2525



Located in the Gooseberry Provincial Park, fishing, hiking and biking trails compliment this picturesque course that is fun for golfers of all levels.

6 Coronation Golf Course

5201 Mary Street **CORONATION** 403-578-4250



Boasting wide and forgiving fairways, with undulating greens this course offers a relaxing golf experience.

7 Country Nine Golf Course

Hwy 21 – 4.5 km north of **BASHAW** 780-372-2427 www.countrynine.com



Country Nine is a challenging course featuring fairways peppered with water and sand traps and for golfers with a slice or hook, you really need to keep your eye on the ball.

8 Double Dam Golf Course

Hwy 609 / West of **ROSALIND** 780-375-2154



This eighteen hole course offers a scenic country setting, with the front nine surrounded by trees, while the back nine is level and open. Overall, this is an enjoyable, walkable course.

9 Edgerton Golf Course

Hwy 610 – 1 km east of **EDGERTON** 780-755-2462 www.edgertongolfcourse.com



This challenging nine hole golf course features immaculate grass greens and beautifully treed fairways. This course will provide a challenge to every golfer, no matter the skill level.

10 Forestburg Golf Club

North of Town on Hwy 856 **FORESTBURG** 780-582-3693



Don't let the beautiful treed fairways and immaculate grass greens lull you into a sense of security - this course provides a challenge to every golfer no matter what the skill level.

11 Hardisty Lakeview Golf Course

Town of **HARDISTY** 780-888-2288



Located in the Hardisty Lake Park, the course is heavily wooded, with well groomed fairways that play narrow, rolling terrain that produces unpredictable lies and deceptive, undulating greens – all the ingredients for a challenging golf game.

12 Hughenden Golf Club

Hwy 13 west of **HUGHENDEN** 780-856-2066



This friendly course, built in 1922, is noted for its excellent grass greens and well groomed, but deceptive fairways featuring challenging grass bunkers and water hazards. A unique feature of this course is that you must cross a provincial highway twice.

13 Irma Golf Club

2 km NE of the town of **IRMA** 780-754-2184



This course, situated in a picturesque valley, is challenging to all golfers with water hazards coming into play on six of the nine holes, and fairways with rolling terrains ending with some interesting sloping greens.

14 Miquelon Hills Golf Course

Hwy 623 east off Hwy 21 to **MIQUELON LAKE PROVINCIAL PARK** 780-662-2499



Located adjacent to Miquelon Lake Provincial Park, this 18 hole course provides a great golf experience in a natural environment. The front nine is a par 27 and the back nine is a par 37, making the course is attractive to golfers wanting a quick break, or a longer game.

15 Provost & District Golf Club

4801 - 49 Avenue **PROVOST** 780-753-6478



The course has long, wide-open fairways that are appealing to the average golfer while providing a bit of a challenge with water hazards and bunkers strategically placed. The clubhouse has a pro shop and is a great place to relax and enjoy a meal with friends or family.

16 Riverdale Golf Course

15 km north of Wainwright on Hwy 41 **WAINWRIGHT** 780-842-2996



The Riverdale Golf Course is unique in that it features two separate 9 hole courses to challenge golfers of all skill levels. The first nine is a Par 3 course with a total of 1400 yards – the back nine is a regular 9 hole course of 4349 yards. The natural trees, bushes, and river valley hills create a challenging course that demands good shot-making.

17 Sedgewick Golf Course

Located on the north side of **SEDGEWICK** 780-384-3670



Mature tree-lined fairways featuring deceptive flat terrain with subtle breaks and quick greens guarded by bunkers create a challenging course to play but a pleasure to walk.

18 Silver Creek Golf Course

25 km south of Camrose on Hwy 21 **CAMROSE COUNTY** 780-855-3982 www.silvercreekgolfcourse.com



At 6549 yards, Silver Creek possesses excellent length for an 18 hole course, while providing interesting water challenges on several holes. A highlight of the golf experience is the Silver Creek clubhouse – a 1912 restored barn furnished with antiques from the 1920s which provides that relaxing 19th hole play.

19 Tofield Golf Course

19110 Hwy 14, south of **TOFIELD** 780 662-3457 www.golftofield.ca



An ideal course for golfers of all skill levels and well known for its manicured greens and great hospitality. However it is not without a challenging dogleg and the small green nicknamed "the postage stamp."

20 Viking Golf and Country Club

4431 - 55 Avenue **VIKING** 780-336-3424



This course, located in the heartland of Alberta's prairie, features generous fairways, extremely thick rough and strategically placed ponds affecting play on seven of the nine holes, contributing to an engaging golf game.

21 Wainwright Golf Club

1505 - 2nd Street **WAINWRIGHT** 780-842-3046



This 18 hole, 6,400 yard golf course awaits your challenge. The front nine is a blend of links style and wooded holes lined with rough and the original nine boasts lush, tree lined fairways – both sections famous for rewarding straight shots and penalizing the errant ones.

22 Whistle Stop Golf Course

3.2 km north of Camrose on Hwy 833 (53 Street North) **CAMROSE COUNTY** 780-672-6490 www.whistlestopgolf.com



Wide open space and big blue sky make this course a relaxing way to play 18 holes of golf, ending with a "round" at the full service clubhouse.
