





OFF-LEASH WALK

While you can visit any park including city and provincial parks with your pet on leash, here are the top spots in the Camrose area for off-leash adventures!

Camrose (Stoney Creek Park):

During the summer, the river valley south of Camrose Drive (hwy 13a) becomes a playground for you and your pet to roam off leash. Start your journey at the Stoney Creek Centre (on leash for approx 1km).

Camrose also has a dedicated year round off-leash park on the west end.











Ferintosh (Little Beaver Lake):

Check out this 1.6km trail loop near Ferintosh. It is generally an easy route but the trail is unmowed which makes wading through the grass challenging at times.

Pleasure Island (8km southeast of Camrose): With ample parking, picnic areas, and mowed trails, the Camrose & District Fish & Game Association maintains a perfect playground for pets to roam freely!

PATIO BREAK

Unwind in the shade of a patio with a refreshing beverage for you and your pup! Watch for the pet friendly symbol to find other places to visit and places to stay.

Marrow. Restaurant & Lounge:

Located in the former feedmill, this striking brick building is a charming place to stop for a drink and a meal!

The Sweeterie: With sweet treats, exotic candy, ice cream, and coffee, this is a patio you won't want to skip!

ICE CREAM AT THE LAKE

Mirror Lake is an iconic space to walk with your pet. Follow the paved trails and don't forget to stop at OleO's for an ice cream reward!

Just so you know: This is a 2.3km loop that takes approximately 30 minutes to walk. Start at the Visitor Information Centre. If you bring a paddle board or boat, you can take your pet with you on the lake.

MUSEUMS & HISTORIC SITES

Camrose is located in a travelling route and home to the Maskwacis Nêhiyawak, Niitsitapi, Nakoda, and Tsuut'ina Nations, the Métis, and other Indigenous peoples. Their spiritual and practical relationships to the land create a rich heritage for our learning and our life as a community.

Settlers began arriving in Camrose in the early 1900s. The Camrose railway depot was constructed in 1911 following the completion of the railway connecting Camrose to Vegreville in April of 1910.

Freight service began in November of 1910 through Camrose and was followed by passenger services beginning in 1912. The freight line primarily transported agricultural products like grain and cattle as well as coal.

Many early homesteaders were from Sweden and Norway and skiing became a popular past-time that continues today. Camrose was first known


as Stoney Creek (named after the creek flowing through the city) and incorporated as Sparling in 1905. Due to similar town names elsewhere in Manitoba and confusion with mail deliveries, the town was incorporated as Camrose in 1906. The Camrose community formed around the bustling railway hub and the agriculture industry thrived due to the fertile soil and plentiful precipitation.





A lesser-known historic hotspot is in Duhamel, 20 minutes southeast of Camrose. In 1910, the Grand Trunk Pacific Bridge was one of the largest wooden rail bridges ever constructed. This community was originally established by the Hudson Bay Company as a trading post, operated by Metis people that arrived from Manitoba around 1880. Today,

although the bridge has been gone for over 100 years, the quiet rural community has access to the valley where people enjoy hiking, paddling, and snowmobiling in the winter. The Verdun School and St. Thomas Church(built in 1883) near Duhamel are beautiful historical places worth visiting.




Just so you know: The Mirror Lake walking loop is a great place to start your journey. The loop is 2.4km and takes approximately 30 minutes.



OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES







The parks in Camrose are known for hosting 38km of paved trails and 20km of cross country ski trails. The ski trails are groomed for classic and skate skiing.



Mirror Lake is the heart of historical Camrose and is a great place to go for a walk, stop for an ice cream, and check out the Visitor Information Centre.

Non-motorized boating is permitted on Mirror Lake as well as skating in the winter as weather permits. Basketball, baseball and tobogganing is accessible from the Grand Drive parking lot on the north side of Mirror Lake.



This park connects Mirror Lake and Stoney Creek and is a primary outdoor meeting place with three covered picnic shelters, a playground, and accessible outdoor workout equipment.

Partake in disc golf at the 9-hole course and tobogganing during the wintertime.

Stoney Creek Park

Stoney Creek Park hosts the cross country ski trails in winter and has paved and natural surface trails. Park at the Stoney Creek Centre (off Parkview Dr.) or the Four Seasons Rotary parking lot (50 St.) The summertime off leash dog walking area is in Stoney Creek Park south of Camrose Drive.

Rudy Swanson & Kin Park

Many indoor recreation facilities are hosted here including hockey rinks, indoor walking track, the aquatic centre, curling rink, and more.

Visit the spray park, skateboard park, football field, beach volleyball courts, baseball diamonds, and soccer fields.




















WINTER ACTIVITIES

Winters in the Camrose region are a wonderland for outdoor adventurers. Superb cross-country skiing, snowshoeing, ice skating and tobogganing make cold days so fun. The scenic trails at are perfect for winter hiking, while the nearby lakes are popular for ice fishing and skating.

Cross Country Skiing

Stoney Creek Park has over 20km of groomed cross country ski trails.

Need to borrow skis? The Dr. Garry & Dorothy Gibson Nordic Ski Library is hosted at Augustana. Contact Campus Recreation at augfit@ualberta.ca for more information.

Miquelon Lake Provincial Park, 30km north of Camrose

Cross country skiing and skijoring (with dogs) is permitted although trails are not groomed regularly. Fat biking, skating, snowshoeing, and hiking is recommended.

Cooking Lake-Blackfoot Provincial Recreation Area, 65km north of Camrose

With more than 170km of cross country ski trails, Cooking Lake-Blackfoot is home to the Canadian Birkebeiner Ski Festival, wildlife viewing, snowshoeing, ice skating, snowmobiling, skijoring (with dogs), equestrian trail riding, and day-use.
